## PLAY AND FAMILY SUPPORT TEAM

BARCA-Leeds is a community development organisation that provides health and education services to children, young people and adults. Our aim is to help people achieve their full potential and contribute to their neighbourhood's social and economic well-being.

## Think Family Service

Think Family is commissioned by Leeds City Council and offers intensive family support to those with children aged 8-13 years. Think Family is a city wide service with BARCA-Leeds delivering to LS12 and LS13 in the West, Health for All in the East and South and Barnardos within North East and North West.

We work with families who are affected by:

- Domestic Violence
- Alcohol or Substance misuse
- Poor Parental mental/physical health
- Sub standard housing which affects children's well being
- Significant difficulties in children's behaviour management
- Parents/carers with learning difficulties
- Significant difficulties in household management and budgeting

We accept referrals directly from families and partner organisations.

## Targeted Play

Funded through BBC Children in Need we deliver play sessions for children aged 5-13 years affected by addiction e.g. alcohol/substance misuse within their family. We use play as a tool to help children build confidence, gain new skills and form relationships which in turn helps them make positive choices about their lives. We run these play sessions during the school day in partnership with local schools and after school in partnership with Hollybush Children's Centre.

## Mobile Play

This service is funded by the Big Lottery and Leeds City Council. We deliver open access mobile play sessions for children aged 5-13 years across West Leeds. We deliver play activities close to where children live, often outdoors, involving children in decision making about their play in order to reduce anti-social behaviour and social exclusion. Current venues for mobile play sessions include Swinnow Moor, Gamble hill Drive, Bramley Park, Mount Cross Women's Refuge and Hillside Refugee Centre.

## Out of School Club/Playscheme

We run an Out of School Club based at Bramley St Peters Primary School. This runs term time after school 3.15-6pm and is primarily for children aged 4- 11 years. During school holiday periods this operates as a play scheme running from 8am-6pm. As a registered charity, we do have to charge for this service in order to cover our costs, there is no profit incurred. This service is aimed at local working parents or those in education.
